Effective December 31, 2021, Legal Services of Northern California discontinued providing self-help services for civil matters to self-represented individuals on behalf of the El Dorado County Superior Court (Court).

Civil Self-Help Services – Effective January 3, 2022

Effective January 3, 2022, self-represented individuals may seek free assistance with civil matters such as small claims, unlawful detainers, name changes, landlord-tenant and civil harassment restraining orders through the Court's Office of the Family Law Facilitator/Self-Help Center located at the Main Street Branch, 495 Main Street Placerville, CA 95667.
