Status of Administration

On February 14, 2024, petitioner filed the final inventory and appraisal. Having received no objection before the March 15, 2024, inventory and appraisal hearing, the court took the matter off calendar. On March 21, 2024, creditor Jennifer Allen filed an objection to the final inventory and appraisal. To date, there is no final account and request for order of final distribution in the court's file.

Previously, petitioner filed a petition to appoint successor guardian, indicating that this is a transfer from Shasta County Superior Court. To date, the court has not received a certified copy of the Shasta County Superior Court's file.

The minor's father executed and signed paragraph 4 of the Judicial Council form GC-211, consenting to petitioner being appointed guardian and waiving further notice. Further, petitioner submitted a declaration of due diligence regarding her efforts to locate the minor's mother. Good cause appearing, the court finds that service of the notice of hearing and a copy of the petition on the mother should be dispensed with because she cannot with reasonable diligence be given notice. (Prob. Code, § 1511, subd. (g); Cal. Rules of Ct., rule 7.52.)
