On July 18, 2024, the court issued a tentative ruling granting petitioner's June 24, 2024, petition for final distribution. At the hearing on July 19, 2024, petitioner informed the court that he intended to file an amended petition. The court continued the matter to August 9, 2024, to allow petitioner to file said amendment. Petitioner filed an amended petition for final distribution on August 6, 2024. Absent objection, the amended petition is granted as requested.

Welfare and Institutions Code section 5350, subdivision (d)(2), provides in relevant part: "Court or jury trial shall commence within 10 days of the date of the demand, except that the court shall continue the trial date for a period not to exceed 15 days upon the request of counsel for the proposed conservatee."

The motion is granted. Appearances are required to select a new trial date.
