

1. GUARDIANSHIP OF BRIANNA L., 22PR0146**Petition to Fix Residence Outside of California**

On October 10, 2024, petitioner requested to fix the residence of the minor outside of California in Yerington, Nevada because it has a lower cost of living.

The matter was continued from November 15, 2024, and January 17, 2025, because the petition had not been properly served on the minor (who is over the age of 12) or the parents of the minor, as required under Probate Code section 1511, subdivisions (b)(1) and (3). (Prob. Code, § 2352, subd. (e)(2).)

On January 17 (after the hearing), petitioner submitted due diligence statements regarding her unsuccessful efforts to locate the parents of the minor. The court notes, however, that the due diligence statements primarily focus on the merits of the petition, as opposed to the efforts petitioner has made to locate the parents. Petitioner states that the minor is in contact with the mother through text message; and the father is incarcerated.
