

1. ESTATE OF MULLINAX, 23PR0016

3. GUARDIANSHIP OF BRIANNA L., 22PR0146

Petition to Fix Residence Outside the State of California

Petitioner requests the court authorize the residence of the minor be fixed outside of California in Yerington, Nevada because it has a lower cost of living.

To date, however, there is no proof of service in the court's file showing that the minor (who is over the age of 12) or the parents of the minor have been served with notice of the petition, as required under Probate Code section 1511, subdivisions (b)(1) and (3). (Prob. Code, § 2352, subd. (e)(2).)

5. GUARDIANSHIPS OF EMMA S., SP20200037

Annual Review Hearing

Letters of Guardianship of the person were issued on December 16, 2020.

The court investigator reports that the minor, the guardian, and the mother each want to terminate the guardianship because it is no longer necessary, explaining that the mother is capable of caring for the minor.

The court may terminate a guardianship on a petition by the guardian, a parent, or the child, based on the child's best interest. (Prob. Code, § 1601.) Notice of the hearing on the petition shall be given for the period and in the manner provided in Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 1460) of Part 1. To date, there is no such petition in the court's file.
