1. ESTATE OF SOILAND, PP20170126

Petition for Instructions

Before the court is the special administrator's request for instructions as to how (and to whom) to distribute Laila Soiland's¹ share of the net proceeds of the sale of the estate's Golden Bird sculpture. The amount set aside for Laila currently exceeds \$850,000.

The special administrator claims that Laila has been missing since at least the mid-1980s.² (Petn., filed Mar. 1, 2024, ¶ 29.) As such, the special administrator questions whether Laila should be presumed dead under Evidence Code section 667 and Probate Code section 12401.

Evidence Code section 667 provides: "A person not heard from in five years is presumed to be dead."

Probate Code section 12401 provides: "In proceedings under this part, a person who has not been seen or heard from for a continuous period of five years by those who are likely to have seen or heard from that person, and whose absence is not satisfactorily explained after diligent search or inquiry, is presumed to be dead. The person's death is presumed to have occurred at the end of the period unless there is sufficient evidence to establish that death occurred earlier."

Dr. Daniel Leu³ disputes that Laila has not been seen or heard from in the past five years. Dr. Leu claims that: (1) Laila personally appeared at the Swiss Consulate in Frankfurt,

Germany, on August 1, 2021, to obtain a passport (Leu Brief, filed Aug. 6, 2024, at 1:10–2:1); (2) Laila handwrote and signed correspondence in February 2022 (Leu Brief, filed Aug. 6, 2024, at 2:2–7); (3) Laila retained Dr. Harald Ramminger as counsel and executed a retainer and power of attorney in 2023 (Leu Brief, filed Aug. 6, 2024, at 2:8–12); and (4) Laila caused withdrawals of funds from her blocked bank account in January and February 2024 (Leu Brief, filed Aug. 6, 2024, at 2:13–18). Further, Dr. Leu claims, the KESB found Laila to be alive as of May 17, 2024. (Leu Brief, filed Aug. 6, 2024, at 2:19–3:23.)

However, as the special administrator points out, Dr. Leu's claims are not supported by admissible evidence. On the court's own motion, the matter is continued to November 15, 2024, so that Dr. Leu may obtain and submit supporting declarations or other admissible evidence regarding his claims.
